14. Solid Waste/Recycling:

Consider approval to purchase a TR310B skid steer with 48" forks for the Recycling Convenience Center in the amount of \$55,400.00, as priced through COSTARS, from Groff Tractor & Equipment.

Consider approval to request bids for the Mustang model 2040 and 2044 skid steers. Both were purchased through a grant in 1999 and are no longer operational.

Consider approval to request bids for the Nissan model #AI35LP forklift. The forklift was purchased through a grant in 2005 and has mechanical issues.

Consider approval for Sheila Shea to attend the 2022 Professional Recyclers of Pennsylvania Annual Recycling & Organics Conference from July 26 - 29, 2022, in Lancaster, PA, for a total cost of \$1,392.00. Consider approval of the MOU with the Pennsylvania Resources Council to hold Fayette County's annual Household Hazardous Waste Collection event on June 18, 2022. Fayette County Conservation District will pay the \$5,000 fee for the event.
