**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF FAYETTE COUNTY
APPROVING RECOMMENDATIONS FOR FUNDING
THROUGH THE
2022-2023 FAYETTE COUNTY LOCAL SHARE ACCOUNT PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the PA Race Horse Development and Gaming Act (Act 2004-71) as amended has established the Pennsylvania Gaming Local Share Account (LSA) through the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development (DCED) for the purpose of distributing 2% of gross terminal revenues of certain licensed gaming facilities in an orderly and timely fashion to support and enhance community and economic well-being and mitigate the impact of gaming and related activities; and

WHEREAS, an LSA has been established by DCED for Fayette County due to gaming revenues generated by the Lady Luck Casino at Nemaquin Woodlands Resort in Wharton Township, Fayette County; and

WHEREAS, Fayette County has entered into a Cooperation Agreement, dated March 17, 2015, with the Redevelopment Authority of the County of Fayette, Pennsylvania, which designates the Redevelopment Authority as the local administrator of the Fayette County LSA Program; and

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Authority has established local guidelines in order to facilitate the local process for administration and implementation of the Fayette County LSA Program; and

WHEREAS, these guidelines indicate that prior to submission of any combined single application to DCED requesting LSA funding, the Redevelopment Authority will present funding recommendations to the County Commissioners for formal approval; and

WHEREAS, for the 2022-2023 Fayette County LSA Program the Redevelopment Authority has prepared a listing of funding recommendations for consideration by the County Commissioners.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Fayette:

1. That the 2022-2023 Fayette County Local Share Account (LSA) Program funding recommendations prepared by the Redevelopment Authority are hereby approved. The Clerk is hereby directed to file an overview of said funding recommendations with the minutes of this meeting.
2. That the County further expresses full support for the 2022-2023 LSA Program Application which will be submitted by the Redevelopment Authority to the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development (DCED).
