**No motion** was made on ZA 21-03 Amendment to Fayette County Zoning Ordinance 1000-108 Definitions and word usage which would amend the following definitions:

GARBAGE and JUNK STORAGE\_ Any outdoor accumulation of garbage, vehicle parts, discarded material, scrap metal, appliance, junked machinery, paper and glass, except such refuse or garbage kept in a proper container for the purpose of prompt disposal, as well as the outside storage or parking of more than two motor vehicles not displaying valid current inspection stickers issued pursuant to the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Bureau of Motor Vehicles, Department of Transportation except for the storage and/or repair of motor vehicles by persons, entities and corporations which have received zoning approval for such storage and/or repair. Additionally, this section shall not apply to the storage of vehicles, vehicles parts, and junk within a fully enclosed garage or other building. Commercial and other heavy equipment shall not be parked in areas zoned as residential.
