

PUBLIC NOTICE
For Selection of Consultant
Fayette County

Notice is hereby given that the County will retain an engineering firm to perform one or more of the following tasks concerning the creation of a Geographic Information System (GIS) database, specifically the digitization of zoning maps:

1. Create a GIS base map with all available base mapping layers
2. Create a county wide zoning layer to be included in the GIS database utilizing the current “onion skin” paper maps (approximately 600-700 maps)
3. Provide the County with an ESRI GIS database which is usable between all departments needing access to the database
4. Complete said project within a 12-month period

The County will evaluate and select the most qualified consultant, subject to negotiation of fair and reasonable compensation, with the following factors:

- A. Specialized experience and technical competence in the type of work that is required (i.e. GIS, zoning classifications, tax maps, etc.)
- B. The firm’s capacity, or availability, of technical staff to accomplish work in required time frames
- C. Prior experience as County Engineer and the understanding of local government
- D. Ability of consultant to expeditiously respond to problems/difficulties
- E. Ability to work with multiple departments in order to obtain/share data, including but not limited to, Fayette County Planning & Zoning, Fayette County Assessment, Fayette County Emergency Management, Southwest Pennsylvania Commission (if necessary).

Firms interested in performing this work are invited to submit one (1) original and four (5) copies of a Request for Qualifications (RFQ) to:
