Prime bidders must be accompanied by certified check, certified bank treasurer's check, bank cashier's check, or bid bond in the form included with the bidding documents. A satisfactory corporate surety shall provide security in an amount equal to 5% of the base bid together with the aggregate sum of all additive alternates. The surety shall name as payee or obligee the Fayette County Commissioners. All contracts exceeding \$10,000 shall contain a provision requiring compliance with Executive Order 11246, entitled, "Equal Employment Opportunity," as amended and as supplemented in Department of Labor regulation (41CFR Part 60-01subpart A).
