Sealed qualification proposals will be received in the Office of the County Controller, Fayette County Courthouse, 61 East Main Street, Uniontown, Pennsylvania, 15401, until 3:00 PM, Monday, May 13, 2024 for the operation of a Juvenile Detention Facility to be located on the campus of the Fayette County Courthouse, in the building formerly referred to as the Jail Annex. The physical address is Rear 61 East Main Street, Uniontown, PA 15401. The goal is for the facility to provide a safe, secure, and rehabilitative environment for juvenile offenders within Fayette County and regionally. Preliminary information indicates the facility will house 12 to 15 male juveniles.

This operation will be autonomous of the operations of Fayette County and the complete and sole responsibility of your organization.
