## Have you served in the military? Do you need help finding a place to live?

*The Support Services for Veteran Families (SSVF) program can help provide housing assistance to get you back on your feet.*

### HOW DO I QUALIFY?

- ★ Veteran, or family member is a Veteran
- ★ Low income
- ★ Homeless, or about to become homeless

### WHAT SERVICES ARE AVAILABLE?

- ★ Housing counseling and temporary financial assistance
- ★ Assistance with VA, rehabilitation counseling, and other benefits
- ★ Employment, education, and training services
- ★ Budgeting, income, and legal support services

### WHAT DO I NEED TO APPLY?

- ★ Proof of Veteran status (i.e. DD-214, VA Medical Card)
- ★ Letter or proof of homelessness— can be from landlord, family member, friend, shelter, or religious organization
- ★ Verification of income— can include pay stubs, unemployment compensation, SSI, SSDI, VA income, or self-declaration of income

SSVF Type of Temporary Financial Assistance	Time/Amount Limitation
Rental Assistance*	Max. of 8 months in a 3-year period; no more than 5 months in any 12-month period
Utility-Fee Payment* Assistance	Max. of 4 months in a 3-year period; no more than 2 months in any 12-month period
Security Deposits or Utility Deposits*	Max. of 1 time in a 3-year period for security deposit; Max. of 1 time in a 3-year period for utility deposit
Moving Costs*	Max. of 1 time in a 3-year period
Emergency Supplies*	Max. \$500 during a 3-year period
Transportation**	Tokens vouchers, etc. –no time limit Care repairs/maintenance-max of \$1,000 during 3-year
