submit for review and approval, prior to contract award, a copy of its Policy Statement developed to implement its drug and alcohol testing program, and to follow the procedures detailed below for specific aspects of the program (such as selection of a certified laboratory, substance abuse professional or Medical Review Officer, or use of a consortium) as determined by FACT.
