The bids received will be considered on an item-by-item basis and an award could be made to the lowest responsible bidder for each item or group of items bid. The prices are to be for 2018 (January 1, 2018 to December 31, 2018).

Submit one (1) original and five (5) copies of the completed bid form sheets to the office of the County Controller, Courthouse, 61 East Main Street Uniontown, Pennsylvania 15401.

Each **price shall include** shipping, handling, new valve stem, mounting and balancing of each tire as well as disposal of the old tire. All invoices **must reflect one price** at the time of the sale. All invoices are to include vehicle make, model, license plate number, odometer reading, name of Fayette County Department and signature of person picking up the vehicle. There should be a description of the work performed on the vehicle. The County requests specification information for each tire. All bidders may bid on any or all items requested.

The Fayette County Commissioners reserve the right to reject any or all bids or parts thereof.

SPECIFICATIONS FOR TIRES

Bid specifications for the delivery and installation of vehicle tires, wheel alignments and other steering mechanical work:

Attached is a list of vehicles that could require tires, wheel alignments and/or other steering mechanical work. The tire sizes currently used are also included. The list could change throughout the year. The County reserves the right to add or delete vehicles throughout the year.

Tires should have the following minimum ratings:

Passenger vehicles – Rating of Traction “A”, Temperature “B”, Tread wear “460”.

Light trucks – Rating should also include at minimum “6 ply” rating.

Larger trucks should include minimum “10 ply” rating, steering tires for the front tires and traction treads for the rear tires.

Sheriff tires should include a 50,000 miles tread rated guarantee, road hazard tire and free rotation.

Tires should be sized appropriate to manufacturer requirements.

Bid for wheel alignments for front and rear alignments should be prices as 2 wheel and 4 wheel.

Bid for mechanical work should be priced as an hourly rate.

Bid for tires is to include cost of tire, installation and speed balancing, disposal of old tire (included any other associated costs but not limited to taxes and environmental cost).

Bid should include cost of road service.

Bid is to include all warranty material on all tires and mechanical work.

Companies that are more than three (3) miles from the Fayette County Courthouse should provide pickup and delivery service from the County buildings which include the Courthouse, 61 E. Main Street, Uniontown; Public Service Building, 22 E. Main Street, Uniontown; Children & Youth Building, 100 New Salem Rd., Uniontown; MH/MR Building, Jacob Lane, Uniontown; Bridge Department Building, Duck Hollow Rd., Uniontown; Federal Building, Peter Street, Uniontown.

Invoices for tires and mechanical work should include the office or department assigned the vehicle, make and model of vehicle and license number, and signature of person picking up the vehicle. To expedite payment all invoices are to be mailed to the Secretary, Fayette County Bridge Department, Duck Hollow Road, Uniontown, PA, 15401.

Successful bidder must have no less than one million dollars of liability insurance. Copy of Certificate of Insurance required.
